



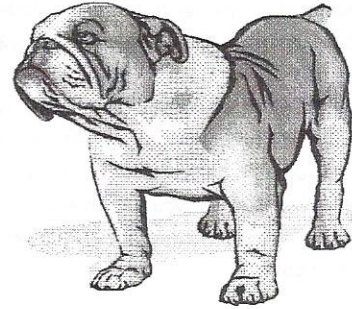
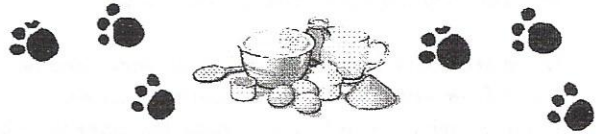

Megan's Mutt Munchies



Wholesome, Healthy, Dog Treats!

Megan's Mutt Munchies are made from all natural, wholesome ingredients, no artificial colors, flavors, or additives are used. The treats have been taste tested by my own English Bulldog, Lady, along with a few neighborhood dogs and some friend's dogs.

There are about four kinds of treats. Garlic Goodies (made from wheat flour, water, oatmeal, cornmeal, powdered milk, minced garlic, margarine, beef bouillon, and eggs) have garlic, which helps a dog's immune system and flea control. They're in a small, circular shape. There are approximately 24 Garlic Goodies in one pack.

Marvelous Milk Bones have wheat flour, water, margarine, powdered milk, eggs, salt, and sugar (only a small bit of sugar, however) in them. Marvelous Milk Bones are in the cat shapes and sometimes you might even get a cat to eat them! Marvelous Milk Bones have about 18 in a pack.

Woof Woof Wonders include wheat flour (like most of the others), water, cornmeal, eggs, and vegetable oil. They are fairly large and hard, so I recommend you give them to large dogs, but it's alright if you give them

to "medium" sized dogs, also. There are 10 of the large bone shapes in each pack.

Lastly, Megan's Original Mutt Munchies, are made of rye flour, white flour, water, vegetable oil, and corn meal. They have about 20 calories each and there are 10 per pack. They are in the cute shapes of the dogs.

Each treat has it's own special taste, even though most of them use common ingredients. It's amazing that just with those few ingredients, you can make dog biscuits! I myself did not know what was in dog biscuits before we started my little business, and really didn't care, until we made them. They are all safe for humans to eat, but wouldn't taste good, especially the Garlic Goodies!! Cats can eat them also, if you leave some lying around with a cat in the house, they'll probably sneak some out, as we have experienced.

I hope you and your pets enjoy these treats!
